The Provincial Hydrological Forecast Center released its February outlook report for Manitoba on February 23rd 2018.

The risk of flooding is low for most Southern Manitoba basins, including the red river.

One potential trouble spot could be the thickness of some rivers and streams with ice thickness being above average, which could cause ice jamming.

The use of the Red River Floodway is unlikely to be used under normal weather conditions.

The next flood outlook will be issued at the end of March.
