Manitoba Infrastructure's Hydrological forecast Center has moved into operational forecasting mode and has begun daily flood updates and production of flood information reports: (<http://www.gov.mb.ca/mit/floodinfo/index.html>)

Flows on the Red River are rising rapidly. With the exception of the La Salle River, water levels on most tributaries to the Red River are beginning to decline. The Red River upstream of the Floodway Inlet within the RM of Ritchot is expected to crest between May 1st. The Red River Floodway is not expected to be operated with these flows. The forecast is being assessed on an ongoing basis and updates will be provided regularly.
